**“Polling for Election 2024 and The Day After”**

Speaker: **Dr. Suzanne Globetti**, UNC Professor of Political Science

The lecturer will be discussing polls and predictions both nationally and locally for Election 2024, which will lie just five days ahead, including how reliable the polls are and why that is so.

Our lecturer will also discuss what to expect “the day after”—how life might or might not change and for whom with a change of administration. For example, what if the house goes Democratic and the Presidency flips to Trump, which would create many different conditions than if there were single-party control.

Dr. Globetti is currently a member of the political science department of UNC after having taught fourteen years at Vanderbilt University and four years at Bowdoin College. She received her BA at the University of Virginia and her Ph.D. from the University of Texas at Austin.

Dr. Globetti teaches a range of classes about American politics and research methods. At Carolina, she’ll offer the introductory American government class, along with courses on the mass media, public opinion, campaigns and elections, and beginning statistics. At Vanderbilt she won multiple teaching awards and was widely considered the political science department’s most successful classroom presence.
